50 YEARS OF PARAGON RECORDS

This is the fourth edition of the Long Eaton Paragon Cycling Club production 'Paragon Records' which covers the period from its formation in 1950 to the year 2000.

It proves to be a most appropriate date, as it completes the Club's 50th Anniversary, during which we successfully celebrated this 'Jubilee' landmark in many ways. We had several special racing promotions, an evening club run and supper at Trent Farm, Shardlow and ended the year with a grand Reunion Dinner at the Regency Rooms, Ilkeston on 28th October 2000 for 242 members, past members and friends of the Paragon.

It was JOE BLACKBURN, a past member and star of the Lancashire club, Anfield B.C., who has been credited as Founder of the Long Eaton Paragon Cycling Club. When he moved to the area, he joined the local Long Eaton CTC Section which contained a 'Hard-riders' group whose ambition was to try their hand at racing.

On an evening in May 1950, a group of these riders, numbering 7 in all and led by Joe Blackburn, pedalled their way from Long Eaton, along the A453 to the A6, a dual carriageway even in those days, to what was then known as the Bondgate Café, Kegworth. From that meeting was born the Long Eaton Paragon C. C., and because of his past experience, Joe Blackburn was elected Secretary and Dennis Filtness, the Treasurer.

The name of the Club was derived from the fact that most of the riders owned 'Andy Bone' bikes from Nottingham, with his trade name 'Paragon'. The badge was designed by Geoff Carrick, the centre piece being the 'wings' of the CTC, the outer rings being the name of the Club which were joined to the centre by spokes. The choice of colours were those of Long Eaton, being old gold and bottle green, so we had the badge associated with Long Eaton by its colours and the CTC with its winged wheel centre.

After humble beginnings, the subsequent years have produced many fine riders at both Club and International levels, and the varied club life has encompassed many club runs to all parts of our

neighbouring counties, youth hostelling trips, social events, cycle shows and the Continental tours and Audax Raids all over Europe.

Who has been the longest serving active member? – probably Bern Rhodes. Who has amassed the most miles and climbed the highest peaks? – Ron Smith. But all the highlights of the various eras can be seen within the enclosed lists.

Robin Harvey first put the Paragon on the cycling map in the mid 1950's with some fast winning rides, but the most successful period in our history was written during the sixties, spearheaded by big Nick Copeman who later emigrated to New Zealand. Mick Potts and Terry Poulter took on the mantle of leaders throughout the seventies together with ladies International Carol Barton, who swept all before her.

Former Tour of Britain rider, Pete Dark, set all our Veteran records in the eighties while the end of the nineties were marked by some outstanding record breaking rides by junior, Simon Wilson. As we settle into the 2000's both Mark Redwood and June Walker have the ability to update some of our longstanding club records.

Who knows where the Paragon will go in the new Millenium as Cycling Clubs tend to be smaller, sponsored teams, but one thing is certain, they will not have the memories that our riders have accumulated over the past 50 years.

OPEN BAR TROPHY

EPNS cup awarded to the member with the best average speed at 50, 100 and 12 hours as in BBAR.

CLUB BAR TROPHY (TAYLOR TROPHY)

Silver cup awarded to the member with the best average speed over BDCA, ANDCC or Club 25; any Central District 50 and any Central District or 'O' course (North Mids) 100.

LADIES BAR TROPHY

Silver cup awarded to the lady member with the best average speed over a Central District or Club 10, and a Central District or Club 25. Presented by members of the former Derby Wheelers CC.

VETERANS BAR TROPHY

EPNS cup awarded to the veteran member (aged over 40 years) with the best average speed over BDCA, ANDCC, National VTTA or Club 25; National VTTA or Central District 50 and any National VTTA or Central District 100 based on standard.

JUNIOR BAR TROPHY (DOYLE TROPHY)

EPNS cup awarded to the junior member (aged under 18 years) with the best average speed over BDCA, ANDCC or Club 10, 25 and 50.

JUVENILE BAR TROPHY

Cup awarded to the junior member (aged under 16 years) with the best average speed over BDCA, ANDCC or Club 10 and 25.

25 MILE CHAMPION TROPHY (PARAGON TROPHY)

EPNS cup awarded to the member who accomplishes the fastest 25 mile ride of the year in a Club, BDCA or ANDCC event.

50 MILE CHAMPION TROPHY

EPNS cup awarded to the member who accomplishes the fastest 50 mile ride of the year in a Club, BDCA or ANDCC event.

100 MILE CHAMPION TROPHY (SWANN TROPHY)

EPNS cup awarded to the member who accomplishes the fastest 100 mile ride of the year in any open event.

12 HOUR CHAMPION TROPHY (BUTTLER TROPHY)

EPNS cup awarded to the member who accomplishes the greatest 12 hour distance of the year in any open event.

HILL CLIMB CHAMPION TROPHY (MRS B FILTNESS TROPHY)

EPNS cup awarded to the winner of the Club Hill Climb.

HILLY TT TROPHY (JACKSON TROPHY)

EPNS cup awarded to the winner of the early season Club Hilly Time Trial.

EVA WELLS TROPHY

EPNS cup awarded to the club member who accomplishes the fastest time in the Club Open 25 mile time trial.

SENIOR ROADMAN TROPHY

Oak shield awarded to the member who collects the most points for placings in road races. Presented by R A Harvey.

JUNIOR ROADMAN TROPHY

EPNS cup awarded to the junior member (aged under 18 years) who collects the most points for placings in road races. Presented by G Hooley.

TRACK CHAMPION TROPHY

EPNS cup awarded to the member who collects the most points for placings in the Nottingham Track League or on Track Merit.

JOE BLACKBURN TROPHY (CLUBMAN OF THE YEAR)

EPNS cup in memory of Paragon founder Joe Blackburn to be awarded to the member who, in the opinion of the Annual General Meeting, has done most for the Club, whether racing, officiating or just plain hard work.

HANDICAP 25 TROPHY

Oak shield awarded to the winner of the handicap competition based on rides in the Club Evening 25 mile Time Trial series. (Best two out of three to count).

HANDICAP 10 TROPHY

Oak shield awarded to the winner of the handicap competition based on rides in the Club Evening 10 mile Time Trial series. (Best five to count).

10 MILE POINTS TROPHY

Cup awarded to the rider with the greatest total number of points in the Club Evening 10 mile Time Trial series.

ANNUAL ROAD RACE TROPHY

Gilt trophy awarded to the winner of the Paragon Road Race.

CARTERS TROPHY

Shield awarded to the winner of the Carters Trophy Road Race.

JOHN PRICE TROPHY

Shield awarded to the fastest schoolboy (aged 15 years and under) in the Club Evening 10 mile Time Trial series. If no schoolboy is eligible, the shield is awarded to the fastest Junior, else the fastest Veteran.

LEN SLADE TROPHY

Shield awarded to the member judged to have performed 'THE MOST MERITORIOUS RIDE OF THE YEAR' – decided by the Committee.

MOST PROMISING YOUNG RIDER

Cup awarded in memory of Len Slade to the young rider judged to have shown most promise – decided by the Committee.

BEST NOVICE

Cup presented by Mrs M Hooley in memory of past president George Hooley to be awarded to the best newcomer to competitive cycling.

CYCLO-CROSS TROPHY

Cup awarded to the best cyclo-cross rider.

FREEWHEELING TROPHY

Trophy awarded to the winner of the Freewheeling Contest – constructed by Dennis Green.

A MOMENT IN TIME -
PARAGON'S RISE TO CHAMPIONSHIP YEAR 1966

Ever since the Long Eaton Paragon C.C. was formed in 1950 as a racing offshoot of the C.T.C. it has had its times of obscurity and prominence. Robin Harvey, way back in 1955, was the first Paragon rider to put the club on the map, when during a season of sub-hour rides he was tipped by 'Cycling' to pull-off the 25 mile T.T. championship. However, the magazine's tip was wrong, and having no team support, Robin (with road man Ron Smith) left the club for a short period to join neighbouring Stapleford Road Club, who, with Dave McLean and Ted Kerry, formed one of the districts top short distance teams to be rivalled only by Nottingham Wheelers. Again disaster struck for Robin, for just as he was settling down in his new club, the Forces called up several of the Road Club's top riders (including Mac) and due to lack of support, the Stapleford Club disbanded.

Robin, always a Paragon man at heart, came back to his first club, bringing with him Ron Smith, Dave McLean, Pete Carlton, Mick Hardy, Collis Hemstock, Spike Austin and myself. Almost at the same time the Ilkeston club, Erewash Valley R.C., disbanded and useful members like Dave Charlton, Barry Minchin, Jammy Jeffries and Snowy 'Pride of Romorantin' Newton were acquired by the Paragon. All this happened around 1960/61 and started the Paragon's rise to be one of the strongest clubs in the district.

With the new influx of riders, Robin retired from racing and took on official club work, leaving Dave McLean to keep the Paragon's name in cyclists' minds. Right from his early days of 'Open' wins to present day team support, Mac has always been a useful rider and this coming season hopes to concentrate on the longer distances. During recent years, top riders like Gordon Booty from the disbanded Ericsson Wheelers and Pete Stark, ex Nottingham Phoenix 'flyer', gave the club its fair share of publicity which brings us to its best ever year, 1966.

It all started in March 1966, when ex Scottish Champion and B.A.R. runner up, Andy Kirk, walked into the clubroom one Tuesday evening after being chatted up by Terry Collishaw at a local early season '25'. Andy had just come down from Scotland to work in Nottingham, but he was already well known south of the Border for his time trialling. It was possible to sense the 'start of something big' in the clubroom that night, and finally Gordon Booty came out with "I've always wanted to win the National '100' team with the Paragon". I thought he was joking, but he meant it. But who was to be the third man? Well you all know now that it was to be big Nick Copeman who has gone from strength to strength and one day will startle the cycling world – even if its only for the way he trains!

Gordon Booty's best ride of the season was definitely in leading the club to a National '100' team win, when in atrocious conditions he put on the pressure in the last 25 miles when every other rider either packed or was reduced to crawling, to record 4.18.50 for 7th place.

Andy Kirk's most satisfying ride must surely be his 1.58.02 victory in the Barnsley R.C. '50' in a thunderstorm, which gave the club its first sub 2 hour ride. Andy, who had gained wins back in Scotland in Paragon colours said after this race "It wasnee th' rain that bothered me, but th' leetning fretned mi ti deth".

Nick Copeman's 'out of the blue' 1.52.10 '50' at the end of the season was proof of his fitness and should keep it in the club's record book for some time.

These riders throughout the season triggered off other great rides, when Pete Stark came second to the National Champion Dave Dungworth with a short '55' – you can't do better than that! This season we could see Pete as the new '25' champ, he's got the mental approach and speed – let's hope 'Cycling' tips him this year and they are right this time.

Road racing has not always been the Paragon's strong side of the sport, but Alan Hitchcock has consistently been the club's top rider. One of the most exciting finishes I saw last season was his 3^d place in the East Mids. Divisional Championship, when 'Scratch' rode a well judged race. In the final gallop he put up a terrific sprint only to be pipped by B Bailey (Beeston R.C.) and Hobby (Newark Castle) who had got away from the bunch. This season should see Scratch with some strong team support and possible individual and team wins.

The Paragon tried everything in 1966 from track to 24 hour racing, which brings me to the Mersey R.R. 24 hour, where I offered to help Geoff Toon and Johnny Barton on their all day rides. Johnny had ridden a '24' before, but Geoff was new to this kind of racing, so the former was really clued-up on the situation and knew exactly what he would be getting for breakfast! Although the conditions during the ride through the night were good, the following day was wet and windy and Geoff's total of 416 miles and John's 409 miles were worthy rides. Birmingham St. Christophers won the team, but one thing is clear, I am sure that the Paragon is capable of a team win in this race, as Geoff beat two of the St Chris's and Johnny beat one, all of whom were long distance record holders. All we need is a third man – any offers? Although a gruelling race, I think the helpers suffer as much as the riders, but I hope to go back to Cheshire for this year's event.

It is a long time since a lady had her name on the prize list, but 1966 saw the emergence of Carol Barton, after several years lay-off, who completely dominated the short distance events in the Central District. Carol hopes to ride 50's and a 100 this year so we should see her name in the Ladies B.A.R.

Although the riders mentioned have given the Paragon either individual or team successes in 1966, it has been a good year for all members. For example, look at the large number who tackled the Nottingham – Skegness race, and good turn outs for end of season club runs. They have all helped to make the Long Eaton Paragon C.C. known both by their keenness and strength in numbers (36 members racing, and had the largest number of entries for the years B.D.C.A. events).

Can the club, therefore, in 1967 look forward to a B.A.R. team win, or an individual '25' mile champion, a 24 hour team win or a grip on a schoolboy race after the thriving number of schoolboys who have joined. Perhaps the emergence of a strong road team or a top 'vet' in Ted Jacobs. If only one of these come off, and it is possible with the talent in the club, then it will give satisfaction not only to the individual rider, but to the other members who will be proud to belong to the Paragon!

As a last thought, how about the Barson brothers (the Dynamic Duo) on their tandem to challenge Thompson – Cooke for the championship.
